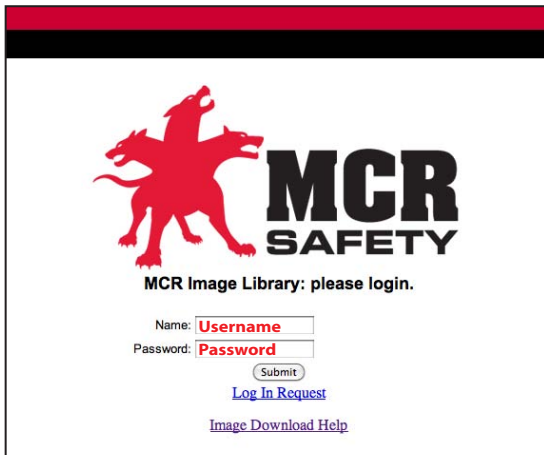


How to Download Images from the MCR Safety Image Library



1. Enter your Username and Password

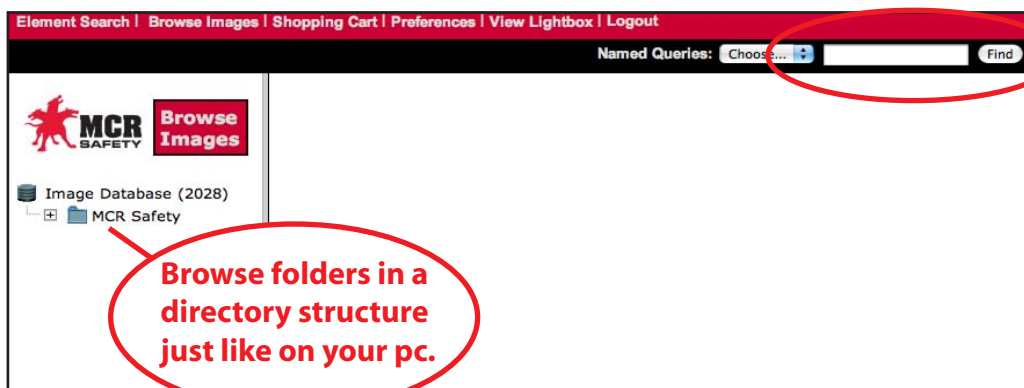
Remember the login is case sensitive.

2. When you login you will enter the Browse Images Search Screen

Browse Images: The Browse Images view allows you to search in the folder directory structure.

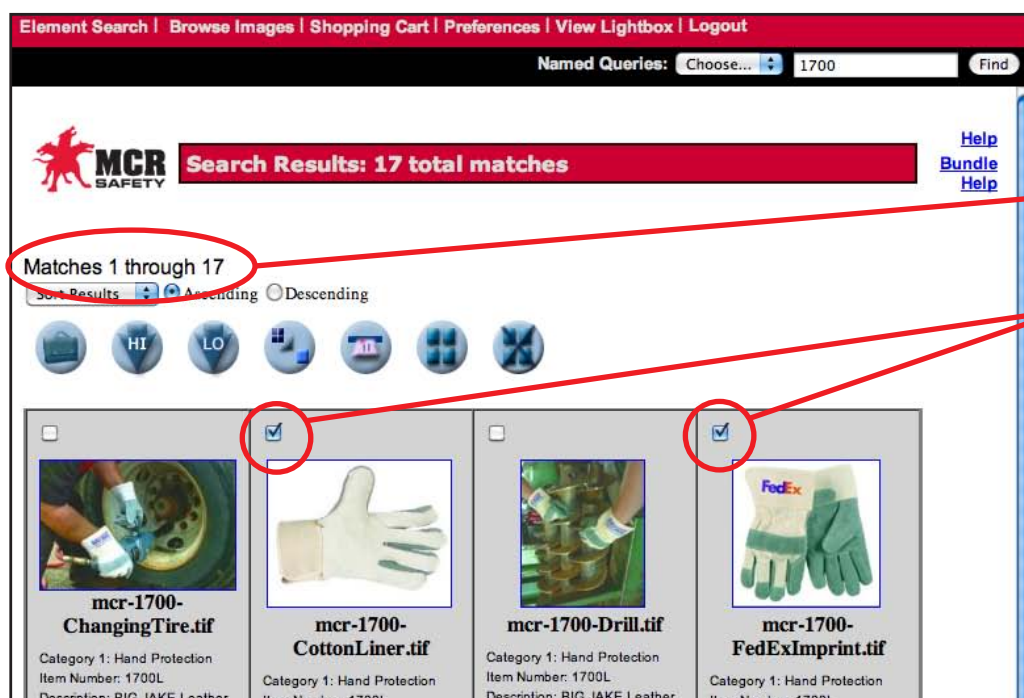
Element Search: Lets you do a detailed search on specific keywords. (Not shown)

Quick Search: Allows you to do a fast search on any random topic.



Quick Search

Fast and Easy to use. Quick Search allows you to do a simple search on any word or description. (example: 1700)



The Quick Search on the description 1700 returned 13 matches in the image database.

Select the images that you want by checking the small selection boxes above the images.

Now that you have the desired images selected, lets discuss what you can do with them.



Add Files to Your Shopping Cart

Click this icon to add images to your shopping cart. The shopping cart will contain all of the images that you have selected and you will be able to view and select the ones you want to download later. The images will stay in your shopping cart until you remove them.



Download High-Res Image

Click this icon to download the selected images in High-Res 300dpi CMYK Tiff format. This method will download in the most commonly used format for color printing.



Download Lo-Res Image

Click this icon to download the selected images in Lo-Res 72dpi CMYK Tiff format. This method will download a smaller file for viewing and placing into a document for print design purposes to be replaced with a better quality image before printing.



Convert Format and Download

Click this icon to download the selected images in an alternate format or resolution. You can select to download the file as a PDF, JPEG, TIFF, BMP, PICT, GIF and PNG. You can change the colors to: CMYK (no change), RGB, Grayscale and Monochrome. You can also change the scale or size of the image when you convert.

Image Descriptions:

TIFF: CMYK - The most common image format used for printing with clipping paths. Selectable Color. Maintains Image Resolution and Clipping Paths. Clipping paths are necessary for dropping out the unwanted backgrounds in product shot photos. Large File size. - 5.5 mb

JPEG: Image using JPG compression to make a smaller file size. Selectable color. Maintains Image Resolution, but keeps and disables clipping paths. Best for emailing to a printer. - 576 kb

PDF: CMYK - Used for easily accessible viewing and printing. Selectable Color. Defaults to 72 dpi. Deletes clipping path. - 4.2 mb

BMP: RGB only - Defaults to 72 dpi. Bitmapped Image. Deletes clipping path. - 4.1 mb

PICT: RGB only - Defaults to 72 dpi. Pict image used in Microsoft suites - 2.2 mb

PNG: RGB only - Defaults to 72 dpi. Picture Image - 1.9 mb

GIF: Index color - Defaults to 72 dpi. PC format images. - 812 kb

Color Mode Descriptions:

CMYK: 4 color process printing inks - C = Cyan (Blue), M = Magenta (Red), Y = Yellow, and K = Black .

RGB: Computer Monitor colors for viewing and video. (RGB = Red, Green and Blue).

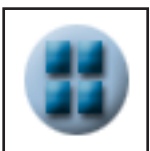
Greyscale: A Black +White photo with varying shades of grey in between.

Monochrome: One color only. Black and white without any tones of grey.



Order Images on CD or DVD

Click this icon to order the images downloaded to CD or DVD. This is a fee based service. You will be asked to provide a payment method.



Select All Files

Click this icon to select all of the images in the current browse window.



Un-Select All Files

Click this icon to un-select all of the images in the current browse window.



Remove from Shopping Cart

This icon will only be seen when you are in your shopping cart. Click this icon to remove the selected images from your shopping cart window.

3. Select the images you want to download

Remember, the more images you select at one time, the longer it will take to download as a group.

4. Select the Download Hi-Res Button

This will process and open the Downloaded Files window

7. How to Convert Format and Download Images

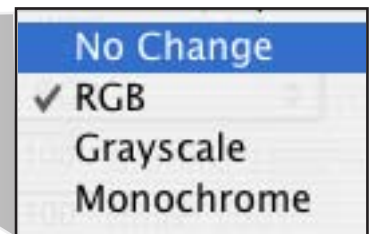
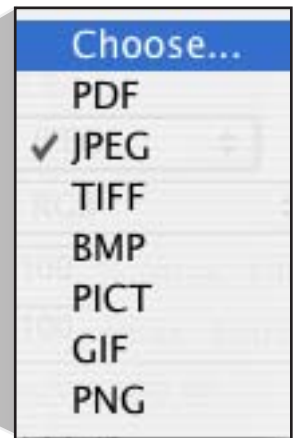
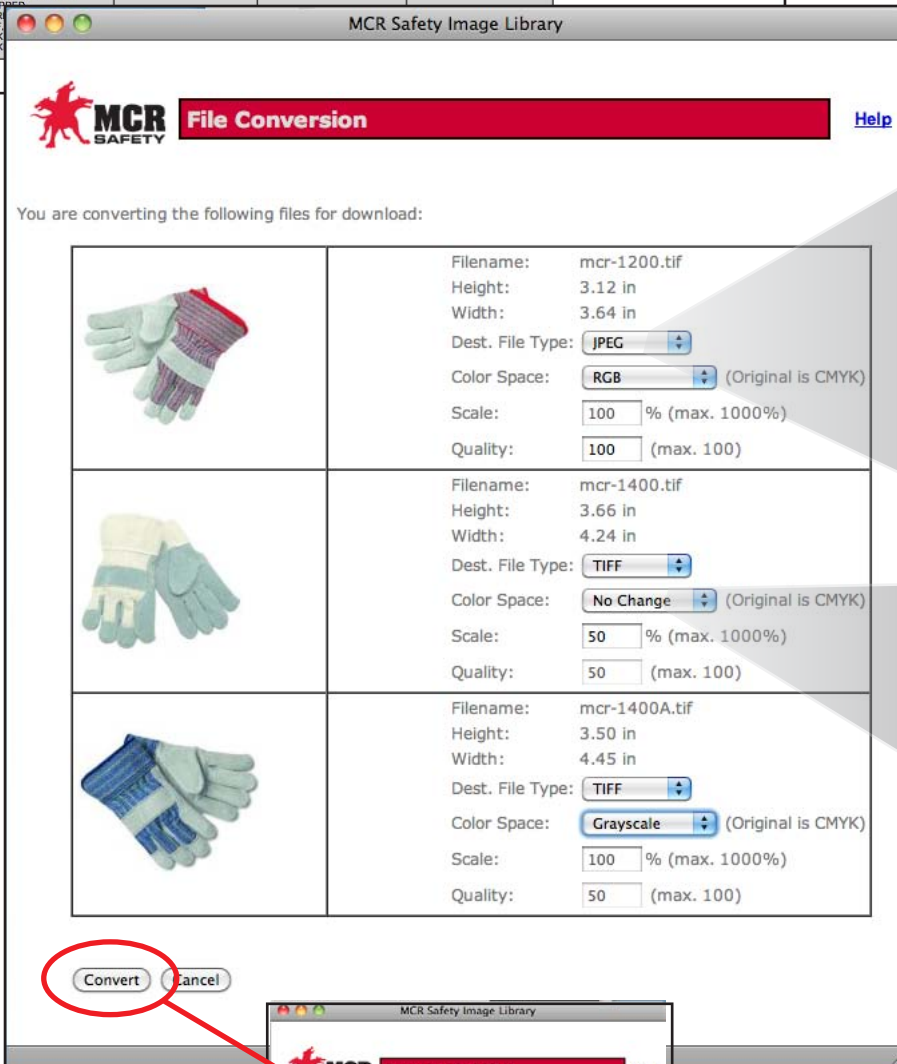
This image shows four files saved to the shopping cart.

A. Select the images desired for downloading.

B. Select the Convert format and download button.

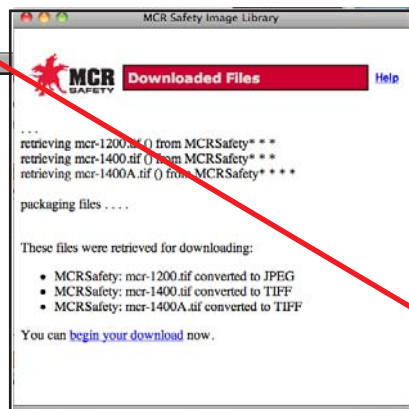
This will open the file conversion window. You will need to make selections for each file to download.

- Destination File Type
- Color Space
- Scale
- Quality



Scale: This refers to the size in inches of the image. If the image is an 8" x 10" size and you only need a 4" x 5" image you only need to download the image at 50%. If you need a 2" x 2.5" image download at 25%.

Quality: Refers to the amount of compression on the image file. 100% quality is lossless compression and is the recommended setting.



Make your selections and Click Convert.
